Genesis

The main idea of the show comes from two critical elements:

The acrobats' desire to perform acrobatic actions in their purest form - melding high risk with unparalleled risk management, creating a fun and complex happening.

Simultaneously, we recognized that the primary motive behind audiences flocking to the circus is one simple yet powerful reason: **to have fun.**

With this realization, it became crystal clear that the next creation from Circus I love you had to be an acrobatic exploration of FUN. What is it? Why do we crave it? What does Fun truly communicate?

While still focusing on the main research guideline of Circus I love you (*What is left of circus once taken outside of its traditional and commercial context and once emancipated from the influence of the other art forms ? In what way is the result of this research relevant for society ?*), the circus is now digging further in the entertainment direction.

It is very clear that very few people of the western society are managing to live a life free of entertainment. The need for it is usually even so big that very few manage to escape entertainment that goes directly against their own ethics.

Our conviction is that the arts of live performance mixed with the wish of entertaining has the potential to be not only ethically sound but also touching, creative and engaging.

Thus, our commitment lies in crafting a performance that aims to elevate and enrich the audience's life through a deep experience of marginality and collectiveness as a way to approach happiness.

Fun n°1 – the glorious nonsense that feels just right.
To the question “why?”, Circus I Love You answers without hesitation: “because it’s FUN.”

With Fun n°1, the international circus returns with a creation that celebrates the absurd and the pure joy of acrobatic movement.

A timeless show, to be shared like a burst of carefree delight.

On the program: club passing, swinging trapeze, Rask wheel, perch, magic, collective acrobatics, tightwire, skywalk, roller skating, aerial straps, and teeterboard — all carried by the wild rhythms of an electro-rock-brass band.

What have we created this time?

Fun n°1 marks a return to a composition centered around the circus act. (Not very innovative within the context of circus history, but for Circus I love you, this is a first.)

The crew of 11 acrobat-musician-technicians does the job of at least three times as many people delivering a varied and multifaceted circus experience full of surprises and good vibes.

Behind a beautiful pink glittering curtain remains hidden the backstage reality of the multitasking artists, constantly changing from a costume to another and grabbing yet another new instrument or circus prop to rush again on stage to deliver even more circus for the audience. In this show, more is more.

As Fun n°1 builds on the idea of encouraging collective joy, revisiting the practice of collective acrobatics Circus I love you first explored in its inaugural creation was the logical continuation to explore further. With years of touring experience that has refined the crew’s skills, the time was ripe for a next level of collective acrobatics, incorporating banquine, teeterboard, perch balancing, and introducing juggling skills previously untapped in the performances of Circus I love you.

While the first creation explored a continuous flow of acrobatics and the second focused on a duo format, the act format of Fun n°1 allows to diversify the palette of acrobatics, to experiment further in rigging possibilities within the circus tent and compose new styles of music to complement the variety of performances.

Our motivation for creating this circus show is deeply rooted in the wish to foster a meaningful collective experience. Through circus we can gather people around common issues that are inherently political but avoid divisive partisanship. By navigating through themes that resonate universally, we aim to create a shared space for reflection that transcends political divides.

Travellers Our show, as well as the life lived as a traveling circus, serves as an ode to marginality, a celebration that leads to an embracing of diversity, ultimately manifesting in a humanist approach to immigration. Through the artistry and nomadic image of the circus, we wish to dismantle barriers and challenge preconceptions, highlighting the richness that arises when diverse voices are woven together, whether it be in the context of people present in a circus tent, a community, or a continent.

Togetherness Our intention is to emphasize the importance of shared experiences with strangers. Our show aims to draw the audience out of their personal spheres, where enjoyment is often shared only by few people already familiar with each other. By encouraging joy and laughter in the company of strangers, we hope to create a communal atmosphere that transcends individual perspectives, fostering connections that extend beyond chosen circles of friends and family. Through these profound yet lighthearted approaches, our circus show seeks to engage audiences in a thought-provoking, inclusive, and joyous experience.

Voluntary simplicity Contentment breeds moderation; a person at peace consumes less. When one feels beauty within, the allure of spending money to alter one's appearance fades away. True fearlessness eliminates the need for weapons; a heart feeling loved and supported refrains from speaking ill of friends. Gratitude begets generosity; a thankful soul shares kindness with others. An untroubled mind peacefully drifts into sleep, a mind filled with joy refuses to be confined; it revels in freedom.

Cultivate joy, and in doing so, reap the power to shape your own life.

Culture politics We strive to bridge the evolving gap between high art and popular culture within the circus field. Our approach centers on the audience's perspective, creating performances that resonate with the desires of current and future circus enthusiasts. Departing from conventional audience development, we acknowledge that art consumers crave novel experiences, surprises, and the delight of the unexpected. Recognizing that the audience expects the circus to be a source of surprise, we embark on a shared journey, marrying their wishes with our commitment to creativity and artistic expression. This method enables us to follow our robust artistic vision, transcending simple solutions. Rather than generating quick thrills or creating only for circus peers, we focus on delivering enduring and enjoyable artistic experiences that beckon the audience to return for more.

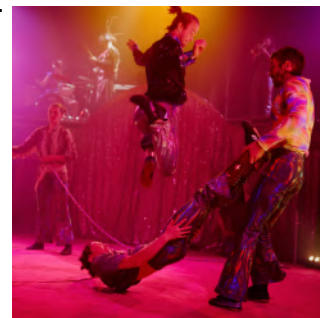

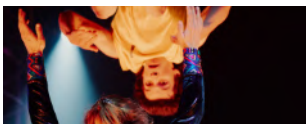
